## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

### Wireless Monitor

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You must have more than one camera configured to the system when using functions that require more than one camera.

After opening the box, fully charge the monitor before use. After initial charge, recharge as needed.

BabyView supports micro SD cards up to 32GB for storage.



The Night Light can be turned ON and OFF remotely only when the camera is paired to the monitor.

If you want to reset the camera, please press the reset button  $\geq$  3sec.

## GETTING STARTED

### Powering Your system



1.Fully charge the system before use.Camera must be plugged in at all times. 2.Push the power button for about 4-5 second to turn on the monitor.

3. To turn the camera "On", press the power switch located on the bottom of the camera. A light will illuminate if it is turned on.

- The bluetooth watch can be charged by only using the provided power adapter.
  - Only use the enclosed Camera Power adapter.
  - Full charge time (Monitor 50 ~ 60min, Watch 7.5 ~ 8.0 hours)

### Pairing Camera and Monitor

The units already come paired for your convenience.

The pair button is used to pair additional cameras. You can assign numbers to the cameras.

To pair additional cameras: Quickly press the button. Do not hold down on the button.

PAIR

Up to 4 Cameras may be paired.

If you have additional camera, pair your camera as follow:

- 1. Power on wireless monitor and wireless camera.
- 2. Touch the live view screen on the monitor to make the settings icon appear.
- 3. Press the [ 🗮 ] button on the monitor.
- 4. Select [
- Select camera number. The monitor will search for the camera when set to pairing mode. A countdown clock will appear at the middle of the screen and will start counting from 30 to 0.
- 6. Press the [PAIR] button found on the bottom of the camera.
- 7. If the monitor successfully pairs with the camera within the 30 seconds, the monitor will automatically switch to the camera's current view.

### Pairing BabyView Watch to your system

- 1. Make sure the monitor is turned on.
- 2. Touch the monitor screen, and the setting icon will appear.
- 3. Press the [ 🔚 ] button on the monitor to show the "Menu" interface.
- 4. Select the [ \* m ] icon on the monitor screen. It should be changed to [\* m ] icon.
- 5. The monitor will search for the Bluetooth watch. When the monitor and Bluetooth watch have paired successfully, the monitor will show that it has been paired, and an" [ 2017] and an " [ 2017] and an "[ 2017] a

### No Signal Warnings

The "Out of Range" message means the monitor cannot access the camera.

Please reposition the camera, or check the camera power.

When your baby monitor displays the "Out of Range" message, please move the baby monitor closer to the camera.

Press the screen of the monitor to display the menu screen.

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### **Function Description**

### VOX (Voice activated)

Select to monitor and listen for significant sound levels with reduced ambient noise.



The screen goes off in "VOX" mode if there is no significant sound louder than a certain level about 30 seconds. The monitor screen turns back on as soon as it detects sound around the camera.

In "VOX" mode, you can set the sensitivity.

- Low Sound Level Detection : Sets to higher sensitivity.
- · High Sound Level Detection : Sets to lower sensitivity.

Remark: When the VOX is triggered, the BabyView Watch will vibrate and show an alert. You can stop the vibration by pressing the button on the side of the bluetooth watch. When the bluetooth watch is outside the bluetooth range, it will vibrate for several seconds, which you can stop by pressing the button on the side.

### Photo Diary

This feature allows you to make a photo diary of your baby. Set the capture time and the camera will take a pitcure once a day in HD. The pictures will be stored to the micro SDcard. If you are not satisfied with the photo of the day, you can reset the capture time and the initial picture will automatically be replaced by the new picture.

### **BabyView Watch**

The watch communicates with the monitor via Bluetooth.

The watch notifies you of any sound detected in the baby's room via vibration and alert icon. If you want to receive alerts from the monitor,

- Please set the VOX ON from the menu.
- Please stay within range of the monitor.

The button on the side of the watch allows you to

- Turn off the vibration alerts
- Turn on the display to check the condition
- When you stop the vibration alert by pressing the button, it will not make additional alert from the same camera during 3min. After 3min, the watch will make vibration alert again. But if there's another VOX event from other cameras during this 3min, then the watch will make the vibration alert immediately.

### **Environment Sensor**

All data from the sensor are for general reference only and is not intended for professional use.

The sensor allows you to create a comfortable environment for your baby.

If you enabled alerts to your monitor, the sensor will send alerts based on the conditions below.

- Temperature: You can set the desired range from the monitor.
- Humidity: below 45% above 65%
- Air Quality: bad condition

The sensor shows the current air quality level of the room via LED light colors:Green/Yellow/ Red.

### Dual-Mode monitoring

You can remotely monitor your baby via BabyView monitor and Wisenet BabyView App at the same time.

The quality from the mobile App may be low based on the netowrk condition.

If you want to use dual-mode monitoring, please see the follow 'Mobile Application' guide.

### Clean sensor

If the dust sensor light remains red after cleaning the room, please use a dust/ air blower to clean the dust sensor vent. Then wipe the surface of the dust sensor fan with a cotton swab or cloth.

Please clean the sensor as stated above once every 3 - 6 months.

Please note that the dust/air blower is not included with the system.



### **Mobile Application**

1. Go to the Google Play or Apple App Store to install the "BabyView" or "WiseNet

BabyView" App " ".onto vour mobile phone.

2. Turn camera on.

3. Press the "reset" button on the camera.

4. Go to your phone's Wi-Fi network list and select "BabyView XXXXXX" which contains the last 6 characters of the camera's serial number located on the bottom of your camera (Picture 1).

5. Open the app and press "Tap here to add device (picture 2).

6. Scan the QR code found on the bottom of the camera or search, then enter in the default password "000000", and click "OK" when finished (picture 3~5).

The monitor will show a "remote" icon on the screen when remotely connected to the baby unit via "BabyView" App.

7. When your camera is connected it will indicate that it is "online"

Press the down arrow and select "Edit Device" → "Advanced" → "Manage Wi-Fi networks" (picture 6-9).

8. Select your local Wi-Fi network and enter the password (picture 10-11).

9. Make sure the SSID savs "Connected" Press "OK" until you are directed back to the camera list. To start live-viewing, select the registered camera from the list and modify your password.



This app is intended for remote viewing with limited functionalities. Main controls are available on the parent unit (monitor). In order to add additional smart devices to the camera. Please directly scan the QR code at the bottom of the camera that you wish to pair with, and input the existing Password for the camera.

## How to install

CAUTION: If you use the system to watch a young child, do not place the camera within the child's reach.

### Wireless Monitor

- 1. Place the monitor in an area that provides clear reception to your camera(s).
- 2. Pull out the stand.
  - Do not pull up the stand lever with excessive force.



### Wireless Camera

Before you install the camera, carefully plan where and how it will be positioned, and where you will route the cable that connects the camera to the power adapter.

Before starting permanent installation, verify its performance by observing the image on the monitor when camera is positioned in the same location/position where it will be permanently installed and the monitor is placed in the location where it will be used most of the time.

### Installation Warnings

Aim the camera(s) to best optimize the viewing area: Select a location for the camera that provides a clear view of the area you want to monitor, which is free from dust, and is not in line-of-sight to a strong light source or direct sunlight.

Avoid installing the camera where there are thick walls or obstructions between the camera and the monitor.

STRANGULATION HAZARD - Keep cord out of child's reach. NEVER place camera or cords within 3 feet of crib or playpen. Never use extension cords with AC Adapters. Only use the AC Adapters provided.

### 1. Carefully unpack the camera.

If you are installing cameras that did not come with the system, please see the pairing camera section of this manual for details on installation.

### 2. Mount the camera to the wall.

Mark the position of the screw hole on the wall, and drill a hole and insert a screw. Then firmly attach the camera to the wall by placing the stand over the installed screw and pushing the base downwards.



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To install on a concrete wall, drill a hole and use plastic anchor to fix.



- The camera can also be placed on a flat surface, such as a table or shelf, and no mounting hardware is required.
- 3. Adjust the viewing angle of the camera.

Use the Pan, tilt control from the monitor to adjust the viewing angle of the camera.

 Adjusting the camera with excessive force may damage the unit.



## TROUBLE SHOOTING
